## DIRECTIONS:

Pour directly into your car windshield washer reservoir. Mixing is unnecessary. The product is ready to use. It is harmless to car finishes and protects to +32°F. Use the windshield defroster to warm the windshield during cold conditions. For below freezing conditions, use Austin's -20°F or -25°F formulas.

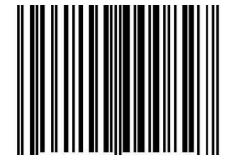

## FIRST AID:

If swallowed: Give 1 or 2 glasses of water. Call physician, hospital emergency room, or Poison Control Center immediately for instructions to induce vomiting. When medical advice is not available, induce vomiting with finger or back of spoon. Get prompt medical attention.

## EYES:

Flush with water for 10 minutes. If eye irritation persists, get prompt medical attention.



## JUMP STARTING—A SAFETY TIP

To start your engine with a booster battery, always follow the instructions below. Failure to do so could result in damage to the charging system and cause personal injury.

1. If the booster battery is in another vehicle, position the two batteries into close proximity to each other. **Do not allow vehicles to touch.**

2. Apply parking brake. Move the shift lever to "Neutral" (On automatic transmission models, move the lever to "P"). Switch off all unnecessary electrical systems (light, heater, air conditioner, etc.).

3. Remove vent caps on the battery (if so equipped). Cover the battery with an old cloth to reduce explosion hazard.

4. Connect jumper cables in the sequence as illustrated.

## CAUTION:

•Always connect positive (+) to (+) and negative (-) to body ground (e.g., strut mounting bold, etc.—not to the battery).

•Make sure cables do not touch moving parts in the engine compartment and clamps do not contact any other metal.

5. Start engine of other vehicle, let it run for a few minutes.

6. Keep engine speed of the other vehicle at about 2,000 rpm, and start your engine in the normal manner.

Do not keep starter motor engaged for more than 10 seconds. If the engine does not start right away, turn the key off and wait 3 to 4 seconds before trying again. 7. After starting your engine, carefully disconnect the negative cable and then the positive cable.

## CAUTION:

•If done incorrectly, jump starting can be hazardous. •Explosive hydrogen gas is always present in the vicinity of the battery. Keep all sparks and flames away from the battery.

•Do not allow battery fluid to come into contact with eyes, skin, cloth or painted surfaces. Battery fluid is a corrosive sulfuric acid solution which can cause severe burns. If the fluid should come into contact with anything, immediately flush the contacted area with water. •A battery rated above 12 volts should not be used for a booster.

•Whenever working on or near a battery, always wear suitable eye protectors (e.g., goggles or industrial safety spectacles) and remove rings, metal bands, or any other metal jewelry.

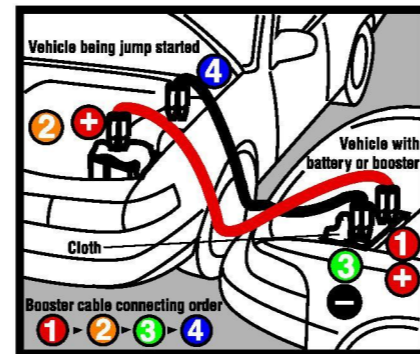
